

San Jose Dance Theatre (SJDT) was originally founded in 1964 as Paul E. Curtis Jr.'s Los Gatos Academy of Dance and the West Valley Ballet Foundation. The name was later changed to San Jose Dance Theatre in 1965 and incorporated as a nonprofit educational organization in 1968.

Across more than 50 years, SJDT has trained beginning through advanced dancers for a lifetime of participation in, as well as appreciation of the art of classical ballet. The Academy is a school that specializes in the classical ballet training of children from 4 years of age to the pre-professional level.

SJDT has delighted local audiences for five decades with performances including *Peter and the Wolf, Alice in Wonderland, Sleeping Beauty and Beauty and the Beast.* The results of the Academy's training have been gratifying. Many of its alumni have gone on to professional careers in dance and in ice-skating.

This year SJDT will celebrate the golden anniversary of our esteemed production of "The Nutcracker."

Miss Hurkmans studied intensely with Larisa Sklyanskaya, former Soloist with Bolshoi Ballet and later with Conrad Ludlow. former Principal with New York City Ballet, and the teachers at The Royal Danish Ballet School. She received full scholarships to the Pacific Northwest Ballet School, The Royal Danish Ballet School and the University of Utah Ballet Department. She performed with the Utah Ballet/Ballet West, Norwegian Andanse Ballet, Zahkraz Dance, and as a guest of The Royal Danish Ballet, and of The Norwegian National Ballet in conjunction with the Year of Dance and the 1994 Olympics in Lillehammer. Linda competed in the 72-country ITI International Competition in Finland. Linda holds a B.F.A., Cum Laude in Ballet Performance, from the University of Utah, Full Pilates Certifications from The Turning Pointe Studios and PhysicalMind Institute, and a M.A. in Psychology from Notre Dame de Namur University. Linda has taught at professional ballet schools in the U.S. and in Europe, Stanford University and Santa Clara University, where she helped found the SCU Pilates Program. Linda currently teaches Ballet at Foothill College and Psychology at De Anza College.

Miss Hurkmans' choreography has been performed by The Norwegian State High School, Zohco Dance Co., Western Ballet, Santa Clara University, Margaret Wingrove Dance Company, and San Jose Dance Theatre.

SJDT Artistic Director Linda Hurkmans will briefly discuss ballet history, work of San Jose Dance Theatre & pointe shoes. Her student dancers will then illustrate the ballet art form by recreating sample scenes. Audience questions are most welcome.
